

10th Anniversary of the European Core Curriculum in Cariology

Dear Members of ORCA, dear Colleagues,

The members of the ORCA Education Committee and the Scientific Committee for the Joint ORCA/ADEE Education Platform in 2021 are very pleased to present you an interesting program for this event which hopefully can take place as a face to face meeting on Wednesday 7 July 2021 in Zagreb/Croatia. On this event the European Organisation for Caries Research (ORCA) and the Association for Dental Education in Europe (ADEE) will celebrate the tenth anniversary of the publication of the European Cariology Core Curriculum. This document was realised by joint efforts of ORCA and ADEE and was published in 2011 in the European Journal of Dental Education and in Caries Research.

The program which you find below includes two reports on the national consensus process for a national version of a Cariology Curriculum which successfully took place in Spain and in Canada. Further two lectures will deal with the challenges of implementation of curricula and one lecture will describe why curricula documents need to be updated from time to time.

In between of these lectures the Scientific Committee for the Education Platform offers a time slot for a **novel type of presentation**. ORCA members and other colleagues who are involved in teaching cariology are invited to **present examples for innovative ways of teaching cariology**. This can be done with the aid of table clinics or posters.

Colleagues who are interested to share their innovative projects in teaching cariology are encouraged to submit a respective abstract through the ORCA website. The deadline for this is the same as for the abstracts on scientific projects that colleagues intend to present on the ORCA Congress 2021. It is possible to submit one abstract on innovative ways of teaching cariology and another on a research project. If you plan to send in more than one abstract, please contact Carolina Ganss, the editor of Caries Research (editor@orca-caries-research.org).

The cariology teaching abstracts will be reviewed in early February 2021 by the Scientific Committee that will decide whether the abstract can be accepted or not. All accepted abstracts will be published together with the ORCA Congress abstracts in the same issue of Caries Research.

Looking forward to receiving many abstracts on innovative projects in teaching cariology and to welcoming you in Zagreb in July 2021
